Acts 10:38 ...how God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and power, and how he went around doing good and healing all who were under the power of the devil, because God was with him.

- Acts 9:17, 18 Paul received
- Acts 9:32-35 Peter showed covenant
- Acts 11:25, 26 Paul teaching

Acts 4:33 With great power the apostles continued to testify to the resurrection of the Lord Jesus, and much grace was upon them all.

Why do we have the three manifestations of the Holy Spirit?

The answer is: Just like we have the three manifestations of God, but still one God.

1 Corinthians 12:4-6 (gifts, service, and working)

1 Corinthians 12:4-6 There are different kinds of **gifts**, but the same Spirit. There are different kinds of **service**, but the same Lord. There are different kinds of **working**, but the same God works all of them in all men. *(emphasis added)*

What is the purpose of the Infilling (Baptism of the Holy Spirit) of the Spirit?

- Acts 1:8 Evidence
- Jude 1:20 Build yourself up
- 1 Corinthians 14:2 Speak to God only
- Romans 8:26, 27 Helps us pray

Do I have to speak with tongues to be filled with the Holy Spirit?

(Tongues are a provision, not a proof)

- Acts 2:4 They spoke with tongues
- Acts 10:45, 46 Cornelius
- Acts 19:6 Disciples
- 1 Corinthians 12:30 Everyone?

Acts 10:45, 46 (KJV) And they of the circumcision which believed were astonished, as many as came with Peter, because that on the Gentiles also was poured out the gift of the Holy Ghost. (46) For they heard them speak with tongues, and magnify God.

D12 Discussion Points

1. Take time to read the scriptures under the section of Acts 2:1-4. We want to be sure people understand that (at New Birth) we all receive the Holy Spirit in us, but we still need Him "on" us and "with" us.
2. The scriptures talking about clothing are very encouraging and good to study.
3. Read and talk about the benefits of the Holy Spirit Baptism.
4. Allow people to discuss the manifestation of tongues. Take some time to discuss the difference between 1) tongues and interpretation and 2) tongues as a prayer language.
